Requirements for PARISHIONERS

Before registering their children at St. Dominic School, parishioners need to contact the parish office (859-336-3569) to verify the status of their parish membership. Active membership requires the following:

❖ **Parish Registration**

St. Dominic Parish families who enroll children at St. Dominic School must be registered parish members.

❖ **Church Attendance**

St. Dominic Parish families who enroll children at St. Dominic School must attend Mass at St. Dominic Church regularly.

❖ **Parish Stewardship**

St. Dominic Parish families who enroll children at St. Dominic School must contribute their time, talent and treasure through enrolling and participating in the parish stewardship program. This requires completion of the annual stewardship form to indicate the ways in which they will volunteer their time and talent at the church. For school families, stewardship of treasure (tithing) is fulfilled through ACH or automatic withdrawal on the 5th and/or 20th of each month from July through June. When completing the ACH form for tithing, parents must consider that the cost to educate one child at St. Dominic School is around **\$4,500** a year. Your tithing contribution supports St. Dominic Church and makes it possible for the church to support St. Dominic School.

❖ **School Stewardship and PTO Support**

St. Dominic Parish families who enroll children at St. Dominic School must contribute their time and talent through enrolling and participating in the school stewardship program. This requires completion of the annual stewardship form to indicate the ways in which they will volunteer their time and talent at the school, including Athletics and PTO fundraisers. In addition, each family is required to pay PTO dues of **\$75**.

❖ **Instructional Fee**

In addition to tithing, St. Dominic Parish families who enroll children at St. Dominic School must pay an instructional fee of **\$1,000 per child**. See "Payment of Instructional Fees and Tuition" on the reverse side for payment options.

Requirements for NON-PARISHIONERS

❖ **School Stewardship and PTO Support**

Non-Parish families who enroll children at St. Dominic School must participate in the school stewardship program. This requires completion of the annual stewardship form to indicate the ways in which they will volunteer their time and talent at the school, including Athletics and PTO fundraisers. In addition, each family is required to pay PTO dues of **\$75**.

❖ **Tuition**

Tuition is applied toward the cost of educating each child enrolled at St. Dominic School, including classroom supplies, technology expenses and other operational costs. The cost to educate one child at St. Dominic School is around **\$4500** annually.

Payment of Instructional Fees and Tuition

❖ **Option 1: Automatic Withdrawal (ACH)**

It is recommended that instructional fees and tuition are paid through automatic bank payment (ACH) on the 5th and/or 20th of each month from **August 5th** through **May 20th**. The ACH form for instructional fees is separate from the parish tithing form. The form must be completed and submitted to the school or parish office by no later than **July 20th** so that the first withdrawals can begin in August.

❖ **Option 2: Payment in Full**

Instructional fees may be paid in full to the school by cash or check by **August 30th**.

❖ **Option 3: Payment in Installments**

Instructional fees may be paid to the school by cash or check in any amount throughout the school year. If choosing this option, the final payment must be made by **May 1st**.

Eighth graders whose instructional fees are not paid in full by May 1 will not be eligible for the annual trip to Washington DC (second week of May). Having an outstanding balance after May 1st also will result in the withholding of students' report cards and other school records until the balance is paid in full.
